National Audit of Breast Cancer in Older Patients (NABCOP) - First Steps

This clinical audit — launched in April 2016 — will evaluate the quality of care provided to older women by NHS breast cancer services in England and Wales. It will do this by using existing sources of patient data collected by national organisations, such as the National Cancer Registration and Analysis Service (NCRAS) in England and the Cancer Network Information System Cymru (CANISC) in Wales.

All NHS healthcare providers are expected to participate in HQIP-funded projects within the <u>National Clinical Audit and Patient Outcomes Programme</u>. NABCOP is one of these projects.

The first steps of this NABCOP project are to understand:

- 1. The organisation of breast cancer care in your hospital Trust or Health Board.
- 2. The patient factors that are most important to MDTs in deciding which treatment options to offer older patients with breast cancer.

Understanding the organisation of breast cancer care in your hospital Trust or Health Board
