

## NABCOP Data Specification for Canisc now online


An updated combined data specification including Cancer Network Information System Cymru (Canisc) information is now available. This specification:

- Lists and provides detail on the Canisc dataset items to be used for Welsh patients, as well as the dataset items to be used for the English patients.

- 3. Is now a spreadsheet (rather than a word document) so that you can sort and filter it. For example to show those data items which are in the Welsh dataset (formal name the 'All Wales Breast Cancer Minimum Reporting Requirement V5.0') as shown on the right.
