NABCOP ANALYSIS TIMELINE

It took a long time for data on a breast cancer patient to be ready for inclusion in the NABCOP annual report. The graphic below outlines the process in England. Patients diagnosed (for example) in December 2020 would have data for investigations, initial treatments and subsequent treatments uploaded via COSD between February and August 2021 – meaning that final registration would not occur until September 2021. From October 2021, NCRAS could quality assure all 2020 data (January to December) and make it available to the NABCOP in December 2021 for statistical analysis.

Once the data had been analysed, the report could be written; this then had to be agreed by the project partners and funders before publication in May 2022.
